

Position: University City Swim Club (UCSC), a member of USA and Ozark Swimming, is accepting resumes for the position of Level 2 Coach (generally ages 7 to 10). This position is open immediately. Each Level Coach has autonomy for his/her own group.

Job responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Foster UCSC's philosophy of offering a competitive swim program in an affordable, inclusive and welcoming environment
- Instruct swimmers in areas of stroke technique, swim endurance, diving, refining breathing techniques, legal starts, turns, finishes and touches, increasing endurance, and developing increased meet readiness
- Enthusiastically motivate swimmers to set and reach their goals
- Actively engage swimmers during practice, attending to the learning and skill needs of each swimmer.
- Use demonstrations and other various ways of description in teaching methods.
- Provide regular constructive feedback to swimmers, encouraging improvement.
- Conduct skill specific clinics as determined by head coach.
- Be prepared to enter the water during swim practice.
- Be available to coach at practice Monday through Thursday, 5:30pm - 7pm
- Be available to attend meets some weekends (2018-2019 schedule available upon request; 2019-2020 schedule to be determined)
- Serve as an integral member of a coaching team.
- Maintain own USA Swimming certification (UCSC will reimburse expenses)
- Follow USA Swimming Code of Conduct and Athlete Protection Policies outlined by USA Swimming.

Applicant must have a love for the sport of swimming and for teaching kids. Applicant must be adaptable to change, honest, professional, and punctual, and feel a sense of accomplishment in helping others to succeed.

- Up-to-date on all required USA Swimming coach requirements. (Required)
- Previous swim coaching experience (preferred)
- College Degree (preferred)
- Competitive Swimming Experience (preferred)
